Abstract

The available literature on the subject emphasizes that contemporary armed conflicts are related to economic and business aspects as never before. The aim of the research is to present the current challenges to counter the crisis in this difficult economic and social period on the example of a selected market sector. Therefore, the article presents the results of research on the impact of armed conflict on the automotive sector in the case study - Poland.
