## The Image of The Police as A Dispositional Group In The Light of Research\*

## Abstract

The image of a police disposition group is formed in the public's consciousness and is important from the moment of first contact and is then shaped over many years. It is influenced both by history, information provided by the mass media and personal contact of citizens with the police officer.
